Class - Nursery

ENGLISH

General Objectives:

The aim is to enable our children to:

- develop their listening ability.
- follow directions and instructions in simple English.
- express themselves in English.
- enhance their motor skills.
- develop their creative thinking.

Topics:

- Phonic drill and recognition of letter sounds.
- Oral introduction of the letter sounds *g, a, j, e*.
- Writing of the letter sounds *g, a, j*
- **Rhymes and Songs:**
 - **English** - 5 Little Monkeys, Mary had a Little Lamb, Tommy Thumb, One Two Buckle My Shoe.
 - **Hindi** - Billi Chuha aur Bandar, Sher Nirala, Dussehra.
- **Stories:** The Little Red Hen, The Enormous Turnip.

Specific Objectives:

Children should be able to:

- draw the letter sounds with firm strokes.
- sing rhymes and songs with enthusiasm.
- listen to stories with focus.
- develop their sequential thinking.
- recognise the phonic sounds of the letters of the Alphabet done.
- enhance their vocabulary.

MATHEMATICS

General Objectives:

The aim is to enable our children to:

- develop their logical thinking.
- enhance their analytical thinking.

Topics:

- Oral counting 1 to 10.
- Conservation of number 6.

- Recognising number 6.
- Conservation of number 2 (revision).
- Understanding and writing numbers 1 and 2.
- Pre-maths concept- same/different (revision).

Specific Objectives:

Children should be able to:

- rote count sequentially from 1 – 10.
- recognise number 6.
- classify, categorise and sort objects related to their number.
- Understand and follow that the placement of objects does not change its value.
- match, sort, order and pair objects on the basis of number 6.
- formation of numbers 1 and 2 with correct strokes.
- differentiate between the things on the basis of same/different.

DISCOVERY SCIENCE
