ENGLISH

General Objectives:

The aim is to enable our children to:

- listen with attention when spoken to.
- speak coherently and participate in conversation.
- understand spoken English.
- express thoughts in English.

- recite all the poems learnt with expression, understanding & movement.
- hold pencil correctly.
- write date and their name.

Topics:

- Introduction of vowel sound 'a'

MATHEMATICS

General Objectives:

- develop logical and analytical thinking.
- use time related vocabulary with increasing detail-yesterday, today, tomorrow.

- Numbers – 1-10
- Read and Draw
- Count and Write
- Shapes
- Developing Shapes

- Estimation
- Conservation of numbers (1 to 5)

Specific Objectives:

Children should be able to:

- use numbers to tell their age.
- identify and draw the common shapes like semi-circle, circle, oval, triangle, square, and rectangle.
- use the following mathematical vocabulary in appropriate situations and demonstrate an understanding of the concept using objects - Tallest- Shortest
- they will count objects up to 10 using concrete material.
- rote count up to 10 by clapping their hands or jumping etc.
- write Numbers from 1 – 10 in squares.
- develop shapes in to new objects.
